
14. KUNAL SINGHAL

 Himachal Pradesh.




26. SANJAY THAPAR

- The man of very firsts in the field of Parachuting; two of his achievements have been acknowledged as World Records and seven others as National Records.


27. SANJEEV SACHDEVA

40. CAPTAIN KANIKA BHARDWAJ

- Captain Kanika Bhardwaj was a dedicated officer in the Indian Army, whose service in the Corps of Electronics and Mechanical Engineers (EME) left a lasting impact. She was raised with a blend of traditional and modern values, instilled with strength and independence by her parents. Despite an early dream of becoming an Indian Air Force pilot, a pelvic injury redirected her path towards the technical side of the armed forces.
- After graduating from the Officers Training Academy in 2013, Capt. Kanika was commissioned into the EME, a role demanding technical expertise and commitment to operational readiness. Her first posting to Kashmir was deeply significant, connecting her to her Kashmiri Pandit roots. She was a part of the historic 66th Republic Day parade in 2015, where she marched before President Barack Obama, symbolizing the evolving role of women in the Indian Armed Forces.
- Tragically, Capt. Kanika's life was cut short in a road accident on January 17, 2016, while relocating to her next posting. Her legacy of bravery and compassion continues to inspire, and in her honor, a park in Paschim Vihar, New Delhi, was named after her in 2022
